As probably all of you are aware, the coronavirus (COVID-19) is currently dominating the headlines and causing a great deal of concern.

I wanted to reassure our families that GSLA is taking steps to monitor what other entities are recommending in our area. We currently plan to follow any recommendations from the Illinois Department of Public Health, DuPage County Department of Public Health, and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention that may be issued. I am in regular communication with local schools, both public and private, to gather as much information as to any potential changes.

As we always do, the staff at GSLA will continue to emphasize proper hygiene and the importance of proper handwashing with students. In addition, a custodian continues to clean the school every day during the week. As always, if your child is sick, please keep him/her at home, especially when a fever is present. If your child has a fever, please keep him/her home for 24 hours after the fever finally breaks (This is our standard school procedure).
